Excerpts of Echoes of India – Vol.3 Issue 3

Babuji Maharaj's 111th birth anniversary was celebrated in

Tiruppur at the DJ Park from 29th April to 1st May. Around 9000 abhyasis gathered on this occasion. On 29th Master conducted satsangh and then released many new publications.

On 30th morning, after satsangh he read out three messages from Babuji Maharaj before solemnising nine weddings.

In the first message dated April 19, 2010 (Babuji's *mahasamadhi* day), Babuji says, "everything works in our way towards this flowering of the soul in its aspiration for the Divine, the ultimate goal of its journey. The (abhyasis) are given the basic elements from the outset. It remains for our candidates to grow through their efforts and perseverance."

The second message received on April 29, 2010, "This gathering of faithful souls here below is touching. A true love song rises up to us. ... Beyond this birth anniversary celebration, it is the whole Mission that rises to the occasion. It attracts the Divine flow illuminating the hearts."

In the message received on 30th morning, addressing our Master specifically, Babuji says, "You are a leader of men, a born organizer. ... May tomorrow's world be united for the better in recognition of the unique power without which it would have been reduced to nothing a long time ago."

Master also reminded that, "Sahaj Marg preaches simplicity of life... Each one of you in your individual life must strive to become simple, reduce your needs, simplify your wants, remembering that Babuji Maharaj has assured that our needs will be fulfilled, our wants are not relevant to the picture at all."

Master stayed at Tiruppur for some days. On the 2nd May he sent the important circular printed here below. He also went to Malampuzha retreat centre, from where he addressed a message regarding transmission in spiritual life.

"... He (Babuji) has defined transmission as utilization of divine energy for the transformation of man. The important point to remember here is this transformation of man is a spiritual transformation and nothing can stop it. So that inside, we become whatever the transmission is – that is – we can become divinised totally – inside – by

His grace. What will not change is our character, our physical circumstances, etc. And therefore Babuji's emphasis on this very important fact that while He can change us inside, character transformation is our business. Cleaning is therefore the most important – remembering the statement often repeated by my Master, that if we transmit to a criminal, he would become a perfect criminal!"

"Dear Brothers and Sisters, Brother Sri Ajay Kumar Batter, in a personal letter addressed to me, citing personal reasons, has requested me to revoke the nomination made in his favour on the 30th April 2005 at Tiruppur, nominating him to be the future president of Shri Ram Chandra Mission.

I have accepted his request with regret, and the said declaration of nomination, known generally as the Tiruppur Declaration, has been rescinded. This is for the information of all members of the Working Committee, functionaries of the Mission, and for abhyasis everywhere.

He has been appointed as the Personal Secretary to the President.

In this they shall co-ordinate their work with the preceptors, regional coordinators and national functionaries in furthering the Mission's objectives. The Mission in the respective countries will provide travel assistance for two travels a year by air in economy class to the RIC's concerned. It is expected that these persons concerned will undertake such travel twice a year to their respective regions."
