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Master's Words

Extracts from "We Have a Duty to Our World" • 24 July 2011, D.J Park, Tiruppur, India

"I am eighty-four and it has been a long life. Any life is the same – your life, my life, you know. All lives are the same, because the goal is the same. It does not matter whether you are a doctor or a carpenter or a musician or one working in a high-tech factory, or the modern equivalent of a high paid genius working in Microsoft or Infosys with a fat paycheque of a crore of rupees, two crores of rupees a year. It does not matter. A fat elephant, a lean elephant, a baby elephant, they are all elephants. What matters is what have you learnt. The longer you live, the more you are expected to have learnt. There is a general tradition, in India at least, that old age must be accompanied with wisdom. On the contrary, there is an English statement or saying, which says there is no fool like an old fool. Which are we going to be?"

"I hope abhyasis will realise that they have a duty to themselves, they have a duty to their race (human beings); they have a duty to the world. We are not desha bhaktas [nationalistic], which is a very narrow and stupid sense. Forget all the songs that you sing on Republic Day and Independence Day. We are universe bhaktas [devoted to the universe]; we are responsible for the universe."



Beloved Master's 85th Birthday "Discipline in Love"

Celebrations in Tiruppur - India



Revered Master's 85th birthday celebrations were held at the Diamond Jubilee Park in Tiruppur, India from 23rd to 25th July 2011. It was a joyous occasion to be with our beloved Master and participate in the function. Master arrived in Tiruppur on 20th July.

There were a total of around 400 volunteers involved in various areas of the meditation hall like stage preparation, water supply, cleaning, decorating, audio- video, security, membership register, etc. Such a large-scale operation could happen with utmost harmony and co-operation only under the divine guidance of our Master. Master inaugurated the meditation hall with the morning satsangh on 22nd July and he conducted the morning satsangh on all days. Around 48,000 abhyasis were present. About 200 tents were put up just to support abhyasis' accommodation.

A big attraction was the Youth Awareness booth (YAB), which displayed and explained all the various activities that the Sahaj Marg youth are involved in. Another big attraction was the children's center, a special large-sized tent was the place for children of all ages to be kept actively engaged with various arts and crafts. The bookstore was a large facility and books in all languages including the publications that had just been released were available for purchase.

A great sight to see in the kitchen was a row of 100 volunteers standing and making chapathis! The kitchen catered to the abhyasis with morning brunch and evening high

tea. A well organized medical center with ambulance and other emergency services was readily available.

On 23rd July, Br. Harshvardhan Gupta, the chairman of the celebrations committee, gave the welcome address after the morning satsangh. At 11:30 a.m., there was a program on the theme of the celebration, "Discipline in Love" and Br. Chakrapani gave a very motivating talk, first in English and then in Tamil.

There were a variety of song and dance programs presented by abhyasis of various centers on the 23rd evening.

The Birthday

Master performed twenty-eight marriages across the three days of the celebration. The concluding satsangh was conducted by Revered Master on 25th July and it was followed by the rendition of devotional poems in Hindi in praise of Master by Sis. Niharika. They were from the heart and each and every abhyasis in the hall could feel the love emanating from the recitation. The closing remarks were by Br. P. R. Krishna who touched on the theme of the celebration, "Discipline in Love". He remarked that we abhyasis have practiced this theme throughout the celebration, and we can be happy that our behaviour has made our Master happy. He categorized the three cardinal problems in our live as Prejudice, Expectation and Judgement and the reason for all these three things is the Ego. With this speech, the celebration came to an end but the overwhelming feeling it left in our hearts will forever stay

Master in Singapore

Rev. Master visited Singapore between the 17th and 22nd of July, 2011. During his visit, he spent a lot of time with local abhyasis and conducted two satsanghs everyday. Some excerpts from his informal conversations with abhyasis are as follows:

- 1.** Too much prosperity kills the soul. Excess money is a danger.
- 2.** Babuji Maharaj was once asked if he was against prosperity. He answered that making money is a question of using one's talents. It must flow like a river from which one takes what is needed.
- 3.** Babuji Maharaj has said that a man is rich if he has what he needs. What you don't need is not yours because you never use it. He also said that to earn for your needs requires very little effort. The essence of Sahaj Marg is all about balance- adding quality and values to life. Not possessing material things, but becoming. Balance is what denotes perfection.
- 4.** Love must be in the heart. It does not matter where else it is or it is not. Discipline comes from this love.
- 5.** One must not pray for spiritual liberation or for ma-

terial things, but for a condition.

- 6.** Babuji Maharaj has said that the best way to see the Master is to see him as your mother since it is a bond that cannot be cut.
- 7.** Test your Master as much as you like. Having tested him, tie yourself to him with bonds of steel.
- 8.** Babuji Maharaj has said that a wealthy man is one who has what he needs. A man whose needs have been fulfilled is a happy man. Happiness is actually a state of painlessness or sorrowlessness. Therefore, a happy life is one without pain.
- 9.** Spirituality says, "Live in the present, for the present, there is no future but the present. Future is the present extended into infinity."
- 10.** Pray for wisdom from the heart, not knowledge. The heart is the giver of wisdom because love is wise. The door to heaven opens through the heart and that is where we have to go.
- 11.** Don't judge anybody by external factors. Always aim at the heart.





Master in Malaysia

Beloved Master arrived in Malaysia on Wednesday, 22nd June 2011 at 2.05pm. The seminar was packed with programs which included talks, meetings and cultural programs. Five speakers gave thought provoking speeches on the theme of the Seminar „One Heart One Humanity’. Some excerpts from his informal conversations with abhyasis are as follows:

- 1.** Master said that he is always happy because he doesn't have any doubts and desires - the two things that make people miserable.
- 2.** Master recounted a question Babuji once asked him - "How to find someone like you who can work for the Mission?" To this, Master replied humorously, "Find a salesman! I have been a salesman all my life. I have sold this Mission all over the world."
- 3.** When an abhyasi asked Master about his availability to meet people, he emphatically replied saying, "I am up to everything - all the time!"
- 4.** Babuji Maharaj has said that human beings do not know love. Love is between the creator and the created alone, not between the created. What is among the created is only affection and mutual dependency, which is

wrongly called love.

- 5.** Bliss is something which is not associated with this world at all, it is a condition. Joy is not a condition, but an experience, as is pleasure. Love is a quality of the relationship between an individual and his maker, like the love between a mother and her child.
- 6.** One cannot love without pain. Love means pain. If there is no pain, there is no love.
- 7.** Don't be afraid of the inevitable - you can neither be afraid nor try to run away from it.
- 8.** When we die, nothing will be lost. When we are born again, nothing will be added unless we are able to change through the course of human life. Only the quality is changed, never the quantity. You neither add nor reduce anything. All that human life can do is to add to the quality of life or destroy the quality of life. One we call angel, the other a devil.
- 9.** When asked if helping others is considered samskara, Master said that what you do for others is not samskara. This is the benefit of service given freely from the heart.

I've never been very adept at religious practices. However, I strongly believed what tradition had taught me; God was somewhere and when we found Him, we would have an answer to our existence on Earth.

Many years have passed since I started my journey down this path. I remember coming here motivated by this outer quest, thinking that what I was searching was to be found outside ourselves.

To be honest, when I first started the practice of Sahaj Marg, I was seduced by the idea of gaining some kind of power, or maybe of developing some kind of purpose that would help me find God, not knowing that the main benefit, I believe, is to become one with Master, realizing that Master is with us at all times, much closer than I thought; this fact simply changed the way I saw life.

The fact that I looked, trusted and changed this search from outside to inside, and that I started to work on my inner self, has helped me observe another world, a brighter world.

When this happened, I realized that I spent my time thinking about the results of my actions, unaware that if you put your heart there, dedicating every action to Master, the result ceases to be important, because things will happen as they are supposed to happen. I am still struck by the realization that in Sahaj Marg the results are not the goal in our lives.

Therefore, each day we must work on constant remembrance. To develop an attitude of surrender and acceptance that Master gives us only what is best for us is a difficult task at the beginning of the meditation practice, but as one progresses, one develops stronger love for what one is doing, and so it ceases to be difficult and becomes part of our lives.

Therefore, I do recommend to newcomers that they surrender their heart to Master. For me, it was difficult at first and I clearly remember the day my heart accepted him; that day I felt deep regret for the time wasted in other practices, and Master, once again, in his infinite love, tells us that the path traveled should not disappoint us or fill us with sadness, because thanks to him we could reach it.



As one follows this path, one realizes that he is not alone, that besides Master, who is with us all the time, and whom we can feel through constant remembrance, there are also the brothers and sisters we meet, meditate with, share things with and who help us feel part of a whole.

Each abhyasi with his or her practice encourages us to move on. To feel this connection in every meditation has confirmed to me that Master is concerned with our evolution. I think it is no coincidence that brothers and sisters around the world are following this practice.

Now I find myself living in a country foreign to where I was born and raised. Upon arrival I made contact with the abhyasis and we have been meeting each other until today. Knowing that Master is in each one of them, in every corner of the world, becomes, in a practical way, the practice of constant remembrance.

Master in my life

I was introduced to the Sahaj Marg system on December 3rd, 2008 the day before my 30th birthday. I must admit that 2 months prior to this, I was surprised to find myself wanting more harmony, peace and wisdom in my life. Why was I surprised? Since my life was void of any many major difficulties which could have caused me to reevaluate my life or to change that which I already had. I had a good a stable job, a long-lasting and steady relationship and some good friends. For me life was good. However, deep within me I was longing for something more, which, I felt, meditation could help me find.

I then remembered a statement that I read in one of my father's Masonic books, when I was younger, which stated: "When the student is ready, the Master will appear." Since then, I thought about it a lot, mostly at bed time. One day, at the detoxification and rehabilitation center where I work, we invited some health care professionals to give their services to the patients. A few weeks later, I learned, from one of my colleagues, that one of health specialists who came to give their services at the center was also a specialist in meditation. So, I contacted that specialist and her name was Judith Joseph.

When I met her for the first time, I was shocked by her simplicity and humility. She told me that she was a preceptor of the Sahaj Marg system meaning, someone who was trained to meditate with others and also explained to me the benefits of the practice. She also assured me that it was free of charge. I was also surprised to see how available she was to come to me. She came twice

in my office during my break time to give me my first two introductory sittings.

At the time of my first sitting, I asked her for the reason why she had come to offer her services at my institution. She said that there was particular reason why she came except that the idea came to her during her morning meditation. So I understood that Master had heard my cry and that He really came to me.

I expected to have great experiences during my meditations such as sensations, visions etc. But nothing happened. I did not feel anything at all but, amazingly, after practicing for only one week I started to notice some changes in my behavior. The first change was my detachment from my television which was my hobby. I used to sleep with my television on. Then came the feeling of inner joy after each meditation. People around me stated to notice that I became quieter and that I started to stay away from noises. But for me, I thought I had found what I was looking for. Since then, I had no doubt concerning my choice of the system.

In December 2009 and January 2010, I was lucky to have been admitted to the Scholarship training program of the Sahaj Marg system, at Master's feet. I cannot even explain how many things I had learned whether on the Sahaj Marg system itself or on myself. I feel blessed that He made me His channel to serve Him. I feel blessed everyday by the fact that I am among those who are "in the boat with Him as the Captain."
